THE FRENCH SCHOOL IN WARSAW

AN INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL

The French School in Warsaw (Lycée Français de Varsovie - LFV) founded in 1919, is an international educational institution which offers the French national curriculum for more than 700 students from 45 countries.

It is the only school in Poland accredited by the French Ministry of Education. LFV is part of the **worldwide educational network** managed by the (Agence pour l'enseignement français à l'étranger - AEFE) which associates 580 French schools all over the world.

Being part of this network allows all students from the French School in Warsaw to pursue their school education in another French school abroad, without any break in their curriculum.

A SECULAR AND CIVIC EDUCATION

Academic excellence is a goal we have for all our students, and we aim for it with kindness and care, so our alumni can take control of their lives in an ever-changing world.

French school education is secular. No religious class is offered at the school and the curriculum focuses on transmitting civic and moral values, while respecting the diversity of religious beliefs

The teaching staff of the French school in Warsaw organizes many school trips and various educational projects in order to help children maintain contact with the Polish language and culture, but also discover French traditions, and make them more aware of the need to protect the environment and respect people from other cultures.



THE FRENCH HIGH SCHOOL



The three-year high school course ends with the **French Baccalaureate**, which is an internationally recognized diploma and a ticket to the best universities and private colleges in France, Poland and abroad.

In addition to general subjects, high school students choose **three additional disciplines** in which they specialize. In order to be better prepared for the prospective university admission, they may receive individual and personalized support.

The program is balanced between different learning times: time for research, group activity, handling; time for dialogue and exchange, debriefing, reasoning; experimental practice and modeling activity, so students gain autonomy and can develop their critical thinking and reasoning skills.

MAIN AREAS OF THE CURRICULUM:

- common literary, historical, humanist and scientific culture;
- scientific reasoning;
- deepening linguistic and communication skills;
- fundamental mechanisms in economics and social sciences;
- concepts and methods on which computer science is based, in its scientific and technical dimensions.



ORGANIZATION AND CHARACTERISTICS

The French High School of the Lycée français de Varsovie welcomes children ages 15 to 18.

High school includes 3 grades:

• 2nde: 15-year-olds • 1ère: 16-vear-olds • Terminale: 17-year-olds

Classes gather around 25 students, so the

monitoring of each child.

The learning program in high school is organized in 3 types of courses:



- > Specialized disciplines, chosen by students. Their number will increase between the grade 1ère and Terminale (three disciplines in 1ère, and two out of three learned in 1ère during Terminale). These disciplines are taught with a significant number of hours, which allows teachers to provide ambitious programs and give students enough time to learn.
- > Optional courses, will also allow students to complete their education according to their professional project and choice of higher education.



INTERNATIONAL POLISH PROGRAM

Since 2020, the French school in Warsaw is offering a **unique linguistic and cultural curriculum** for students interested in learning in depth Polish language. This program is open to all pupils enrolled at the school starting from grade CP.

Children can benefit from:

- 4 hours of Polish language and literature per week;
- 1,5-2 hours of history-geography in Polish per week (great emphasis is placed on the particularities of the History of Poland and the countries of Central and Eastern Europe, while following the requirements of the French program);
- educational, cultural and artistic projects related to the History and heritage of Poland are organized throughout the year.

INTERNATIONAL FRENCH BACCALAUREATE

Students who opt for this scheme will prepare for this new international option during their final two years of schooling. At the French school in Warsaw, high school students can take part in a bilingual program (French-Polish).

BILINGUAL EDUCATION

French + Modern Language A (program language) + Modern Language B

All IFB-specific teaching (deeper cultural and linguistic knowledge, Contemporary studies, the compulsory non-linguistic discipline and optional non-linguistic discipline backed up by a specialist study course*) is followed/taught in their MLA (program language)
